The Graduate Union is nominating two students aged 18 - 26 years, to attend the National Student Leadership Forum in Canberra from the 4th to the 7th September.

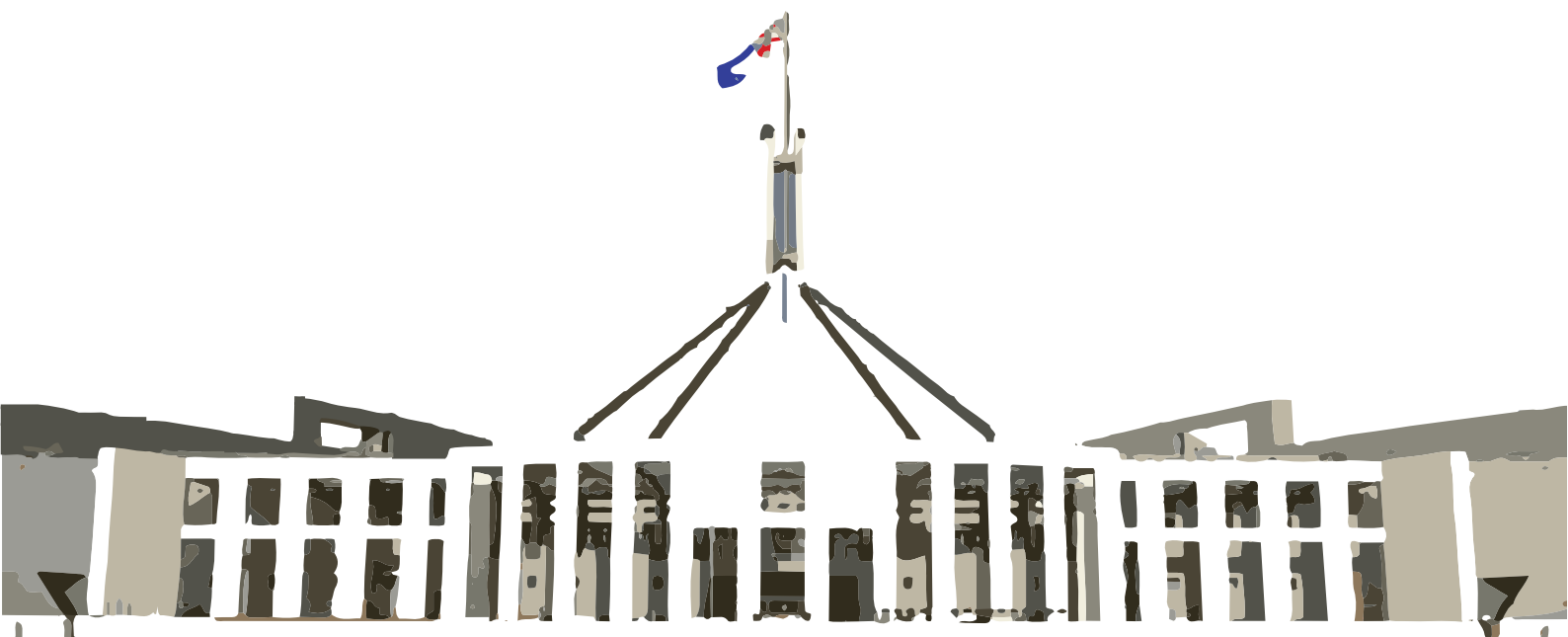
