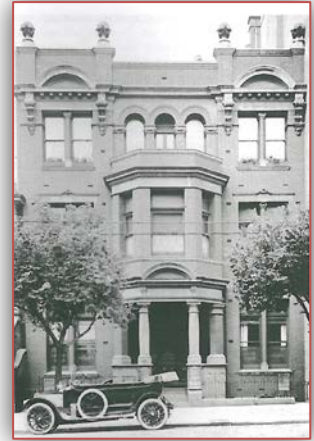

An elected provisional committee attended their first meeting on the 4<sup>th</sup> of May 1911 at the rooms of Dr James Barrett at No. 105 Collins Street Melbourne. From this meeting, three sub-committees were established: a residential university club, a graduates association and an annual graduates day.



## Founders Day Oration

100 years ago, a general meeting of past graduates was held in the Independent Church on Collins Street (now St Michael's Uniting Church) in Melbourne to celebrate the establishment of the Association on the 14<sup>th</sup> of July 1911. Sir John Monash was elected Chairman and the aim of the Association was to set up a residential club.

## April luncheon *reviewed*

Dr Kay Patterson is the Director and Vice-President of Interplast Australia New Zealand. Her address was a very informative and enlightening insight into Interplast, an NGO which provides free treatment to people living with a disability from a congenital condition such as cleft lip and cleft palate or conditions such as burns scar contractures. Voluntary medical teams of experienced reconstructive surgeons, anaesthetists and nurses generously donate their time to provide reconstructive surgery to people and teach, train, mentor, facilitate, and care for all of those with whom they come in contact. 43 activities were delivered in 16 countries in 2009/2010 to treat populations who would otherwise not be able to afford or access such services. Their goal is in effect to not be needed anymore, purely through providing training for staff to continue their work and to further develop local health practitioner skills to undertake more and more of the reconstructive surgery. For example in Sri Lanka over the last 8 years Interplast volunteers have helped establish hand surgery services. They now have a Hand Trauma Clinic within their 'plastics' department and no longer need Interplast in this area, competently performing these procedures independently.

Dr Patterson's address was very well received with much praise given for her work in promoting Interplast.

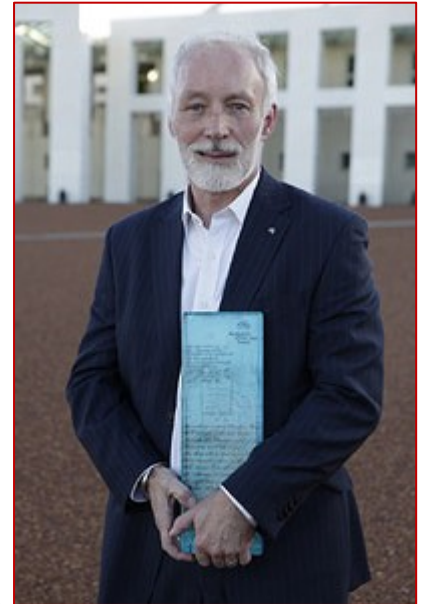
