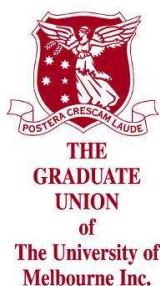

Michael Gawenda is one of Australia's best known journalists and authors. In a journalism career spanning three decades. He has been a political reporter, a foreign correspondent based in London and in Washington, a columnist, a feature writer and an editor.

He has won numerous journalism awards including three Walkley awards.

Michael began his journalism career at The Age in Melbourne in 1970.

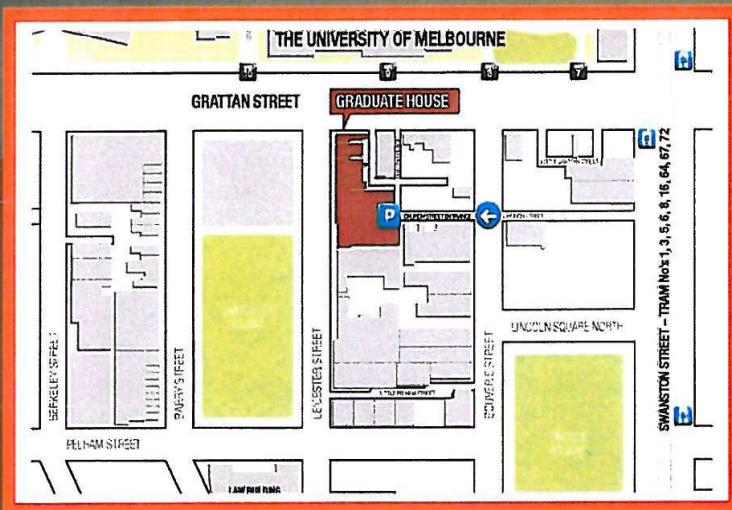
